### **Logistics Readiness Center, Bavaria employee is HERO OF THE WEEK**

KAISERSLAUTERN, Germany – The 21<sup>st</sup> Theater Sustainment Command Hero of the Week is Mr. Johann Lederer of the 405<sup>th</sup> Army Field Support Brigade, Logistics Readiness Center, Bavaria for the week of June 9-13, 2014.

Mr. Lederer distinguished himself while serving as a Facility Manager for the Regional Supply Support Activity (RSSA) Vilseck, Bavaria Logistics Readiness Center (LRC), 405<sup>th</sup> Army Field Support Brigade (AFSB). He is a selfless and dedicated employee whose guidance and direction empowered successful completion of some very significant changes in FY14. Mr.

Lederer was instrumental in the RSSA's successful transition from SARSS1 to GCSS-Army. This transition was a monumental task, requiring significant employee training, 100% inventory accounting and transfer between systems, and DODAAC revalidation. He was responsible for the migration of European Activity Set's (EAS) Authorized Stockage Listing under RSSA's control.

In accordance with a USAREUR directive, he is now 98% complete in transferring former 172<sup>nd</sup> IBCT ASL back to the 21<sup>st</sup> Theater Support Command. He accomplished all of these tasks while also supporting 209 active RSSA customers, to include those previously catered by 574<sup>th</sup> Quartermaster Company, who inactivated their SSA during the same timeframe. He also gained a new customer from the 1<sup>st</sup> Cavalry, from Fort Hood Texas, which is the first European Rotational Force in Germany. Mr Lederer is an exceptional employee whose commitment and professionalism reflect great credit upon the Bavaria LRC, the 405<sup>th</sup> AFSB, and the United States Army.

The 21<sup>st</sup> Theater Sustainment Command, Commanding General, recognizes each Hero of the Week as part of his Commander's Update with a Hero of the Week certificate.
