Lieutenant Colonel George Horne Commander, Army Field Support Battalion-Benelux

Lieutenant Colonel George Horne assumed command of the Army Field Support Battalion-Benelux on June 10, 2024.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, LTC Horne commissioned from Marion Military Institute, Alabama, in 2002 as an Infantry Officer in the New Jersey National Guard. In 2004, LTC Horne began active service as an Armor Officer and in 2010 became a Quartermaster Officer as part of the branch detail program.

As a junior officer, he served in a variety of assignments. From 2002-2004, he served as a platoon leader with Alpha Company, 1st Battalion, 114th Infantry Regiment. Completed Armor Officer Basic Course and Scout Leader Course at Fort Knox, KY, in 2005. Between 2005-2007, he served as an armor officer and and attended Transportation Officer Basic



Course and Scout Leader Course at Fort Knox, KY, in 2005. Between 2005-2007, he served as an armor officer and calvary platoon leader with Comanche Troop, 1st Squadron, 1st Calvary, 1st Regiment of Dragoons. Finally, from 2007-2009, he culminated as the 1st Armored Division G3 Chief of Operations.

Upon graduation from the Logistics Captains Career Course in 2010, LTC Horne commanded Foxtrot Forward Support Company, 1-87IN Battalion, 1st BCT, 10th Mountain Division and was the Deputy Commanding Officer for 10th Sustainment Brigade, 10th Mountain Division. Graduated from Command and General Staff Officer Course, at Fort Leavenworth, KS, in 2016. From 2017 to 2018, he served as the Support Operations Officer assigned to NATO Special Operations Component Command-Afghanistan, Special Operations Joint Task Force-Afghanistan. From 2018 to 2019, he served as the Executive Officer for 46th Aviation Support Battalion, 16th Combat Aviation Brigade, 7th Infantry Division. From 2019-2021, he served as the Executive Officer for Oklahoma City Recruiting Battalion, 5th BDE, United States Army Recruiting Command.

Between 2007 and 2018 he deployed four times to Iraqi and Afghanistan serving in an assortment of positions. Prior to command, LTC Horne served as the lead planner for United States Army Europe and Africa's G37 for Large Scale Global Exercises and with Security Assistance Group – Ukraine as the lead Base Operations Sustainment - Integrator.

LTC Horne holds an Associate of Arts from Marion Military Institute, AL, a Bachelors of Arts in Psychology from Rutgers University, NJ, and a Masters of Science in Logistics and Supply Chain Management from Kansas University, KS.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with oak leaf cluster, Defense Meritorious Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, the Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, and the Army Achievement Medal with two oak leaf clusters, The Joint Meritorious Unit Award with oak leaf cluster, the Meritorious Unit Citation with two oak leaf clusters, the National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal with three Campaign Stars, Iraq Campaign Medal with Campaign Star, and NATO Defense Service Medal. He has earned the Combat Action Badge, and the Recruiter Badge.

LTC Horne is married to Captain Beatrice Horne (USAF) and has one son.
