Lieutenant Colonel Jonathan Neal Commander - Army Field Support Battalion-Germany

Lieutenant Colonel Jonathan "Jon" Neal assumed the duties as the Commander of the Army Field Support Battalion- Germany on 12 June 2024.

LTC Neal was recently assigned as the G33 Chief of Operations for the 21st Theater Sustainment Command from August 2023- May 2024 in Kaiserslautern Germany.

Prior to his assignment at 21st TSC, he was assigned from June 2020 to August 2023 as the Commander of the White House Transportation Agency. Responsibilities included worldwide 24-hour transportation and cargo support services to the Office of the President, First Family, White House staff, Presidential motorcades, Presidential travel, and First Lady travel as directed by the White House Military Office. From July 2019 to July 2020, LTC Neal served as the lead for enlisted talent



management in the Army Talent Management Task Force. LTC Neal served his key and developmental jobs from December 2016 to July 2019 in the 25th Combat Aviation Brigade (CAB), as both the Support Operations officer (SPO) and the Brigade S4.

LTC Neal served in a variety of field grade positions as the Afghan National Defense Security Forces, Director of Logistics, Operations Officer, and in the SPO shop of the 8th Theater Sustainment Command. As a company grade officer, in 2012 Jon was selected as a Joint Chiefs of Staff (JCS) Intern. Following the internship, he served as the executive assistant to the HQDA G-4 Director of Maintenance, strategic mobility action officer, and operations and intelligence action officer for the Office of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. He commanded the 233D Transportation Company (HET) Commander at FT Knox, KY. Other commissioned jobs included the HHC 1st TSC executive officer, and platoon leader of a medium truck platoon. He was commissioned following Officer Candidate School May 2006. Prior to attending OCS, Jon served as an Enlisted Combat Medic from May 1996 to May 2006. LTC Neal has served 5 combat tours in support of the Global War on Terrorism.

LTC Neal has a bachelor's degree in business management from St. Leo's University, and a master's degree in policy management from Georgetown University. He is a graduate of the Command General Staff College, the Combined Logistics Captains Career Course (CLC3), Basic Airborne School, and the Transportation Officer Basic Course.

His military awards and decorations include: two Bronze Star Medals, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, four Meritorious Service Medals, a Joint Service Commendation Medal, five Army Commendation Medals, the Iraq Campaign Medal, The Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the Global War on Terror Service Medal, the Overseas Service Ribbon, the Combat Medical Badge, the Expert Field Medical Badge, the Army Parachutists Badge with Distinguished Bronze Service Star, the Presidential, Joint and Army Service Badges, and Italian Foreign Jump Wings.
