MEMORANDUM FOR All Soldiers TDY or Deployed to USAG-Bavaria

SUBJECT: USAG Bavaria Policy Letter #32, Regionally Aligned Forces Non-Tactical Vehicle Licensing Policy

1. References:

- a. AR 600-55, The Army Driver and Operator Standardization Program (Selection, Training, Testing, and Licensing).
- b. AE Reg 600-55, Driver and Operator Standardization Program.
- c. AE Reg 55-1, United States Army Motor Vehicle Operations on Public Roads.
- d. AE Reg 190-1, Driver and Vehicle Requirements and the Installation Traffic Code for the U.S. Forces in Germany.

2. This policy provides guidance on the applicability of Non-Tactical Vehicle (NTV) licenses (DA Form 5984-E or OF 346) issued outside the European Region, and usage by U.S. Armed Forces TDY or deployed to/or within the USAG Bavaria area of operations.

3. USAG Bavaria recognizes that NTV licensing requirements throughout the Army are standardized, however, regulations in this theater of operations have added training requirements that must be met.

4. A DA Form 5984-E (or OF 346), issued outside the European Region (Belgium, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, and the Netherlands), is authorized and will be honored by USAG Bavaria once the vehicle operator has met the following requirements:

- a. Possesses a valid driver's license from any sovereign country or any State in the United States.
- b. Has been issued a DA Form 5984-E (or OF 346) and DA Form 348 by a U.S. Army garrison approved Driver's Training Station (DTS).
- c. Completion of the U.S. Forces Driver's Training Program for Europe in JKO.

- d. Completion of the U.S. Forces Driver's Training Program Test for Europe in JKO.
  - e. Complete Winter Driving Training annually before 31 October.
  - f. Complete Accident Reporting and Prevention training (within the last 4 years).
5. It is the owning Commander's, or their designated representative's, responsibility to:
- a. Ensure that the above training requirements are met prior to allowing the vehicle operator to drive an NTV in the European Region.
  - b. Maintain a master list of vehicle operators who have completed the required training and provide a signed and verified list to the Garrison licensing office.
  - c. Document the required training completion dates on the license carried by the vehicle operator.
6. For the purpose of operating a standard NTV, and obtaining NTV support, USAG Bavaria will recognize a DA Form 5984-E (or OF 346) issued outside the European Region once the required training completion dates are affixed to the back of the DA Form 5984-E (or OF 346). At a minimum the entries will include:
- a. U.S. Forces driver's training program for Europe completion date.
  - b. Winter driving training completion date (current year).
  - c. Accident reporting and prevention training completion date.
7. In order to validate a bus license annotated on a DA Form 5984-E (or OF 346) and issued outside the European Region, the USAG Bavaria Drivers Training and Testing Station (DTTS) is required to evaluate the vehicle operator for a bus license to ensure they are fully qualified prior to operating a Garrison bus.
